We will also be cleaning out the **Ponds** on Inge and Sellhorn after the City of New Bern did an inspection and found trash in them. This will be an ongoing expense to the HOA unless we control the trash getting into them. So please help to keep our Community Clean.

# Pets

As you know, it is against the law to not do this subject to a \$25 fine from the City of New Bern if you do not pick up after your pet. ## Lawn Care/Items in the Street

When you are mowing your lawn the grass on the curb must also be mowed, so it does not grow into the street.

Basketball sets must be moved off the street when you are finished. They cause a driving hazard on our narrow streets and it is a violation of the Sellhorn Covenants to have them in the street when not in use, and it is subject to a fine if not removed.

Keeping the lawns mowed and the edges along the curb trimmed is also important to keeping our development looking good.
