We have had complaints regarding pets running loose in the development. Please remember it is a New Bern City Ordnance that requires Pets to be on the owner's property or on a leash.

The Sellhorn Heights Covenants Section L, item 11 states that all trash receptacles should be out of view. In consideration of the community please do not throw trash in street or the common areas.. So please help to keep our Community Clean. As a reminder, the City picks up large items along with Trees
